Homes the next generation can afford

A Labour council will spend cash from sales of former council houses to help build affordable homes for local people to rent and buy.



Food waste collected weekly

A Labour council will re-use your waste food to provide energy or compost. We will provide a weekly collection to reduce smells and stop sending food waste to landfill which harms the environment.



Controlling unacceptable behaviour

A Labour council will use existing powers better to control noisy pubs and clamp down on under-age drinking. We expect the police, council officers and housing associations to deal firmly with anti-social residents and we will take tough action against rogue landlords.



Secure play areas and better community facilities

A Labour council will reverse Tory budget cuts (supported by the Independents) to services for families, children and older people.



Safer and cleaner neighbourhoods
